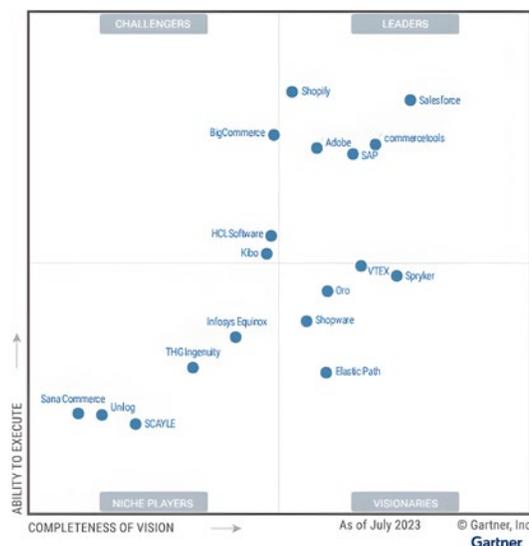

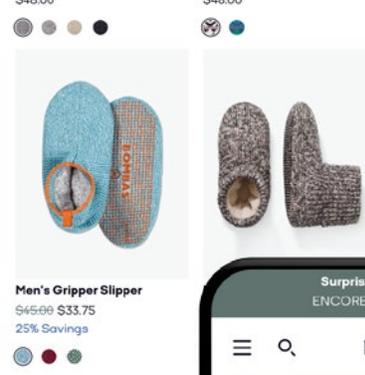
On average, Adobe Commerce's total cost of ownership is 41% higher than Shopify's, according to research commissioned by Shopify from a leading independent consulting firm.

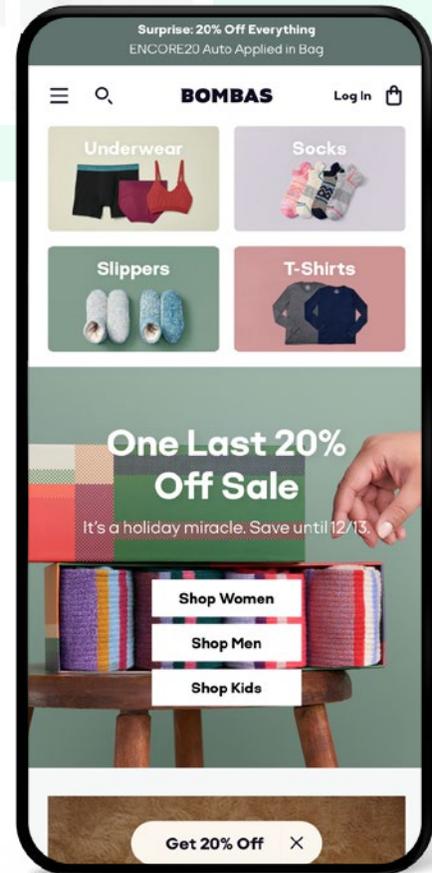
How Bombas replatformed for stability and saved thousands

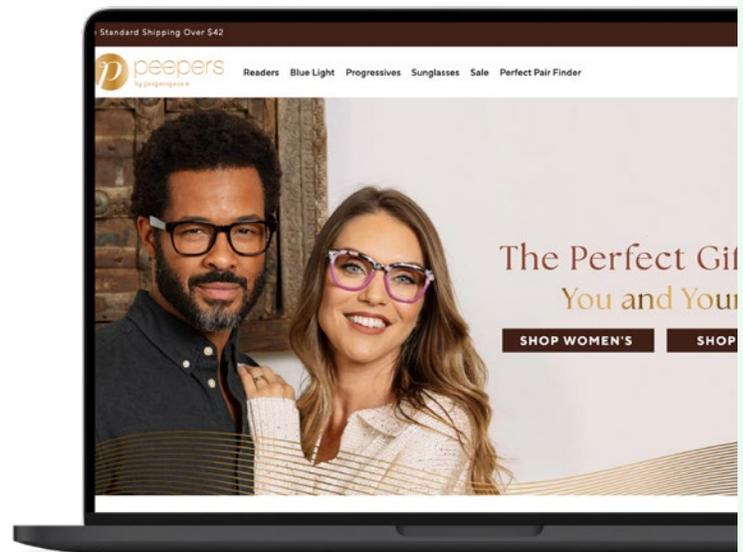

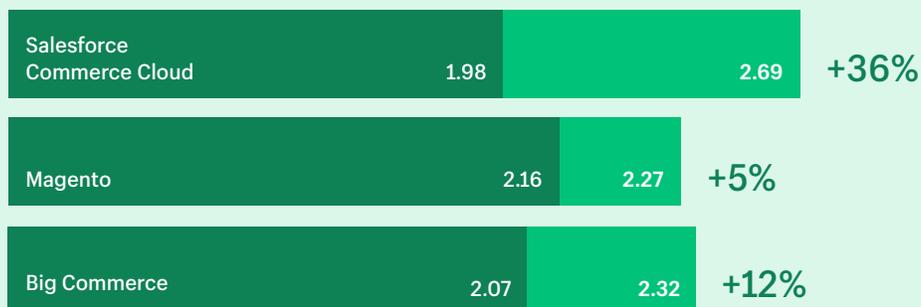
Conversion rates that can't be beat

Shopify users benefit from having the world's highest-converting checkout, as named by an independent study conducted by one of the Big Three consulting companies. The customizable one-click checkout powers 10% of US ecommerce and is trusted by the biggest brands.

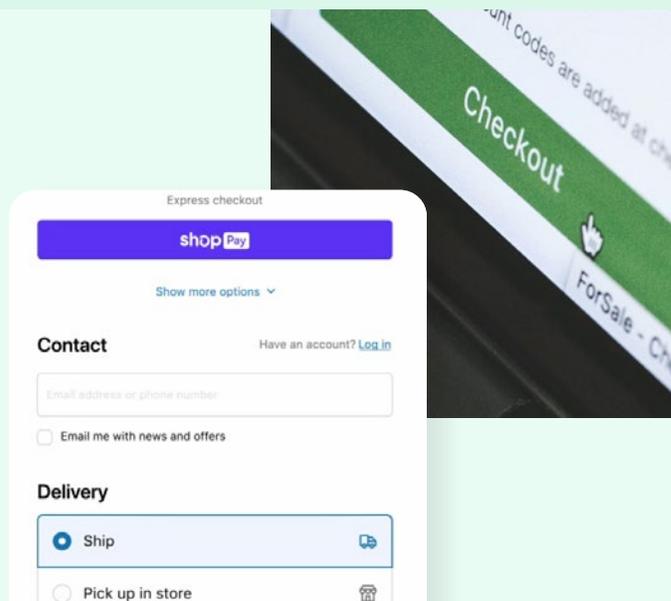
According to a study of ecommerce conversion rates, Shopify's proprietary checkout, Shop Pay, converts 5% better than Adobe Commerce. It also lifts conversion by as much as 50%, outpacing other accelerated checkouts by at least 10%.

Cross-platform benchmarking

When leveraging "like-for-like" samples, Shopify outperforms peers up to 36%, and by 15.2% on average.



The Shopify checkout also provides a customer experience that's now recognized—and sought after—by shoppers who value the look, feel, and flow of Shopify's checkout. Just the presence of Shopify's one-click checkout drives a 5% lift in lower funnel conversion, even when it's not used. Customers know Shopify's checkout is fast, seamless, and secure, with options like discounts, tax and duty calculations, and delivery options.



Innovation meets customization

Shopify brands appreciate the ability to customize their checkout to meet the needs of their customers and stay ahead of competitors. With hundreds of engineers shipping improvements every day, Shopify builds features for more conversions so that you don't have to.

Since Shopify's checkout is constantly updated, tested, and optimized, it is the highest converting checkout, especially paired with the Shop Pay ecosystem of online purchasers. Along with giving retailers an unparalleled marketplace advantage, brands can also customize their checkout to match their branding, adjusting elements like color, font, logos, and images, and editing the checkout fields.

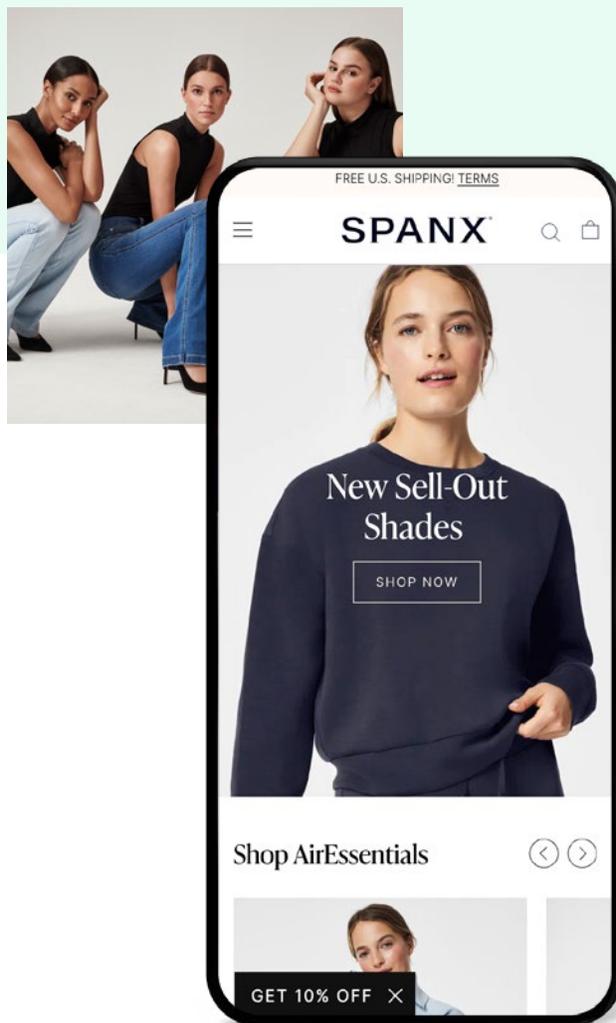
In addition to customization options, Shopify retailers enjoy smooth, built-in functionality like discounting engines, product bundles, shipping rates and delivery promises, global tax systems, flash sales, upsells and cross-sells, and loyalty programs.

It's the tight relationship and feedback loop between Shopify's product, UX, and engineering teams that make the smooth integration of these features possible.

While Adobe Commerce has the capability to offer many of these checkout customizations, it comes at the cost of lengthy and expensive development costs, plus maintenance.

How Spanx increased conversions and became more agile using Shopify

The Spanx team knew they needed a more agile back-end that allowed them to make changes faster. After migrating to Shopify, merchandising tasks and other changes to their site are 30% more efficient. These operational efficiencies were made sweeter by the 10% jump in conversions they saw after migration.



Customization where it counts

Ecommerce design is important. The most effective brands strike the right balance between originality and familiarity. You want to stand out from the competition but ensure customers can find and purchase your products and services easily.

A misconception about Shopify is that retailers don't have design flexibility or the custom functionality that Adobe Commerce provides. That's simply not true.

Retailers on Shopify have the flexibility to design a custom theme, or install a Shopify Theme Store template and extend it.

One of the benefits of being on Shopify is that many workflow automation features and functionalities are included. This helps reduce the number of apps you have to integrate, update, and pay for, as well as your dependency on developers to make basic changes. It also frees up both invaluable developer time and gives non-technical teams autonomy over their tasks.

If you do need additional capabilities, our partner app ecosystem provides specific functionality for features they specialize in. Apps and extensions are easy to find and install, and likely don't require the assistance (or cost) of a developer to get started.

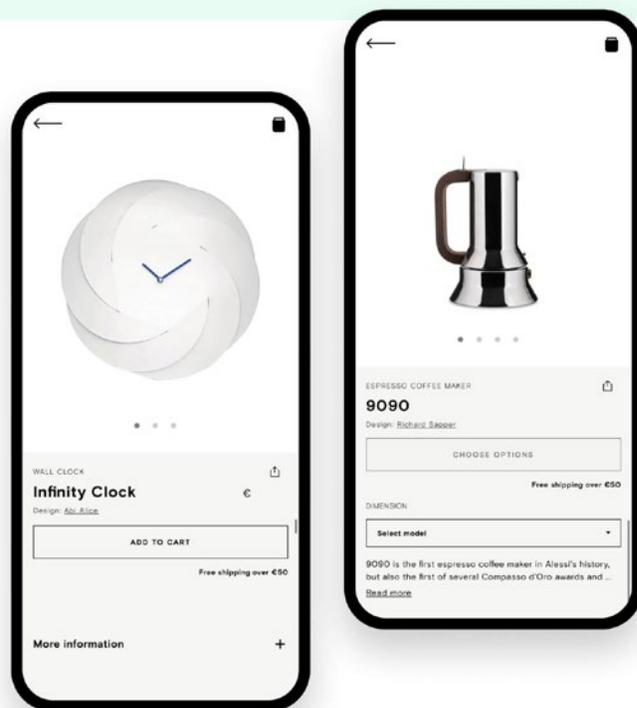

Reliability and security you can trust

Shopify offers 99.99% uptime and built-in security. In contrast, the uptime of Adobe Commerce sites depends heavily on how much virtual processing power a retailer has bought—and sites can go down when the answer is, “not enough.”

Reliability is essential for businesses. If you are paying for hosting, storage, security and support, in addition to a developer to maintain your site and licensing fees, it's reasonable to expect it to perform.

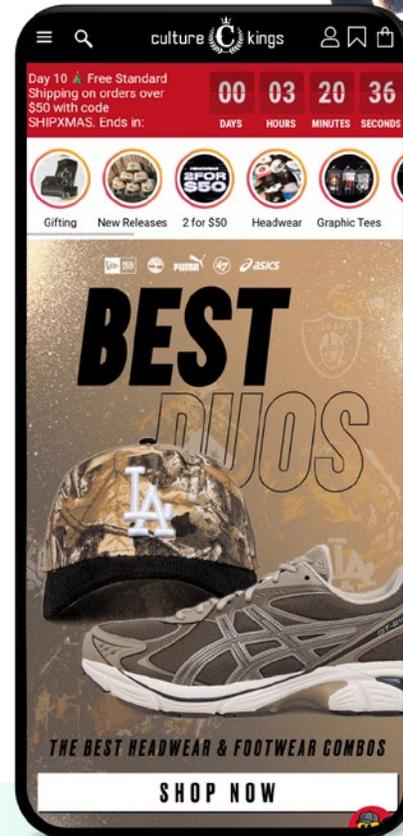

In addition to reliability, brands choose Shopify over Adobe Commerce for site security.

It's a given that customers expect their information to be kept and processed securely when buying from an ecommerce store. Brands put their trust in Shopify to ensure their own data, and customer data, is secure.

All stores powered by Shopify are PCI compliant by default, so you can keep payment info and business data safe. Shopify's certifications are a commitment to maintaining that trust.

Shopify has an SSL certificate installed as standard, encrypting data transferred between browsers and online stores. It also covers all six PCI compliance standard categories, and applies to every store using its platform, keeping businesses and customers secure. This means individual retailers don't have to certify their own sites.



Adobe Commerce shifts the responsibility of PCI DSS compliance onto the retailer, which means brands need to independently ensure that their code is PCI compliant and go through the auditing process to get PCI certified. This process can be extremely time consuming and tedious.

Retailers trust Shopify to keep their stores safe, and switch from Adobe Commerce to Shopify with that goal in mind.

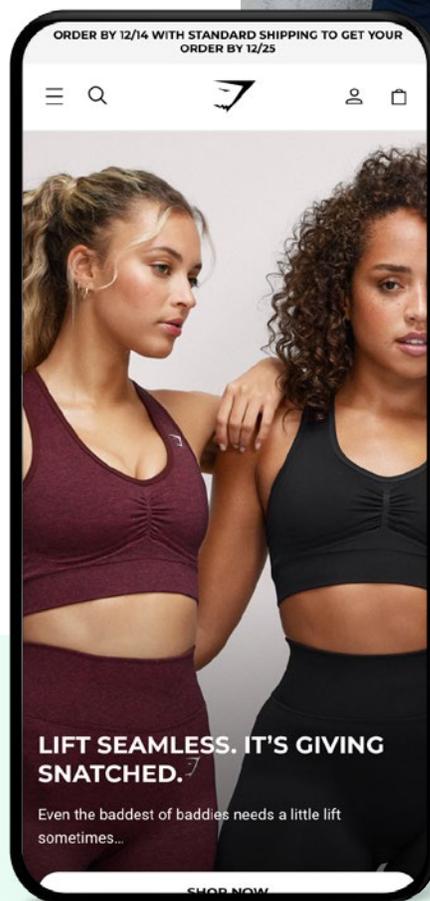
